A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A DONATION OF \$1,500 TO "BROWARD VICTIM'S RIGHTS COALITION, INC."; PROVIDING FOR FUNDING FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida approves a donation of \$1,500 to "Broward Victim's Rights Coalition, Inc.", utilizing funds from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund.

**SECTION 2**: That the donation is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Margate.

**SECTION 3:** The Chief of Police recommends the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$1,500 in State Law Enforcement Trust Funds ("LETFs") to provide the \$1,500 donation to "Broward Victim's Rights Coalition, Inc.".

**SECTION 4**: The Chief of Police certifies that the donation of \$1,500 in LETFs to provide to "Broward Victim's Rights Coalition, Inc.", complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds will be used for an appropriate law enforcement purpose.

SECTION 5: The Chief of Police certifies that the donation of \$1,500 in LETFs to "Broward Victim's Rights Coalition, Inc." complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds are not being used as a normal source of revenue for the Police Department.

**SECTION 6:** The Chief of Police certifies that the donation of \$1,500 in LETFs to "Broward Victim's Rights Coalition, Inc." complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds were not considered in the adoption and approval of the Police Department budget.

**SECTION 7**: That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
