AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 2-78 POWERS AND DUTIES; AMENDING APPENDIX-A ZONING; ARTICLE GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTION 3.22. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; ARTICLE VII TRANSIT ORIENTED CORRIDOR CORRIDOR (TOC-C) SECTION 7.3 TOC-C DISTRICT, USES; ARTICLE VIII PERMITTED TRANSIT ORIENTED CORRIDOR GATEWAY (TOC-G) 8.4 DISTRICT, SECTION TOC-G GATEWAY PERMITTED USES; ARTICLE IX TRANSIT ORIENTED CORRIDOR-CITY CENTER (TOC-CC) DISTRICT, SECTION 9.5 TOC-CC CITY CENTER PERMITTED USES; ARTICLE XXI NEIGHBORHOOD BUSINESS B-1 DISTRICT, SECTION 21.3 PERMITTED ARTICLE XXII COMMUNITY BUSINESS DISTRICT, SECTION 22.3 PERMITTED USES; ARTICLE XXIII LIBERAL BUSINESS B-3 DISTRICT, SECTION 23.3 PERMITTED USES; ARTICLE XXXV ADULT BOOKSTORES AND ADULT MOTION PICTURE THEATERS, SECTION 35.1 LOCATION RESTRICTED; PROVIDING FOR THE ELIMINATION OF MINIMUM SEPARATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ESTABLISHMENTS LICENSED TO SERVE OR SELL ALCOHOL; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Section 2-78 - Powers and duties, is hereby amended to read as follows¹:

Sec. 2-78. - Powers and duties.

(a) The board shall have the following powers:

 1 CODING: Words in struck through text are deletions from existing text, words in <u>underscored</u> text are additions to existing text, and shaded text are changes between First and Second Readings.

- (1) To hear and determine appeals where it is alleged there is error in any order, requirement, decision or determination made by an administrative official in the enforcement of the zoning regulations of the city.
- (2) To hear and grant or deny such variances from the terms of any zoning ordinances of the city. To hear or deny such variances from the Code of the city as will not be contrary to the public interest or the general purposes sought to be accomplished by the zoning ordinances and where, owing to special conditions, a literal enforcement of the provisions of the zoning ordinances will result in unnecessary hardship in the use of the property involved.
- (b) In exercising said powers and duties, they shall not grant a variance unless:
 - (1) It shall be demonstrated that special conditions and circumstances exist which, if there is a literal and strict enforcement of the provisions of a zoning ordinance, would constitute a hardship or practical difficulty in the use of the property involved.
 - (2) The board shall find that the granting of the variance will not be contrary to the public interest or the general purpose sought to be accomplished by the zoning ordinances.
 - (3) In granting any variance, the board shall record in its minutes the circumstances and conditions constituting the hardship or practical difficulties upon which the variance is based.
- (c) The board shall not have jurisdiction to consider any variance allowing any use of buildings or lands not permitted within any designated zoning classification.
- (d) The board shall not have jurisdiction to consider any variance of distance requirements for liquor licenses from freestanding Broward County public schools and approved charter schools, pursuant to [Appendix A,] section 3.22 (VIII) (A).

SECTION 2: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Appendix-A Zoning, Article III GENERAL PROVISIONS, Section 3.22 Alcoholic beverages, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3.22. - Alcoholic beverages.

. . .

(VIII) Distance restrictions. The City does not require a minimum separation from establishments licensed to sell or serve alcohol.

- (A) Distance restrictions from a house of worship, school, or daycare. No liquor license approval or beer and wine license approval for consumption on the premises shall be issued where the place of business designated in the application therefore is within one thousand (1,000) feet of a house of worship or a public or private elementary, middle or high school, or child care center. The distance shall be measured from the main entrance or front door of such house of worship, school, or daycare to the main entrance of such place of business in accordance with subsection (IX). For any location within any zone designated under any business classification to which a license for the sale of liquor or beer and wine for consumption on the premises has previously been issued, and which license is subsisting and in use, no house of worship, public or private elementary, middle, or high school, or child care center shall be permitted within one thousand (1,000) feet of said location. The distance shall be measured from the front door of the licensee to the main entrance of the house of worship, school, or child care center. Any proposed use not meeting the specific distance restrictions listed above shall be prohibited.
- (B) Distance from adult bookstore or adult motion-picture theater. No establishment for the sale of any alcoholic beverage for consumption on the premises shall be located within one thousand (1,000) feet, to be measured from front door to front door of said establishment by airline route, of an adult bookstore or adult motion-picture theater located within or without the corporate limits of the city.
- (C) Distance restrictions for 3APS (beer, wind, and liquor package sales only). No establishment for package sales, with a 3APS classification, shall be located within one thousand five hundred (1,500) feet of another 3APS classified establishment.
- (IX) Reserved. Distance measuring generally. Measuring distances shall be from the front door of one (1) establishment to the front door of the other establishment, in determining the

distances called for in this section, and according to the following rules:

- (1) Distance will be the result of measured length along property lines abutting a street, going across the street, if necessary, in any direction.
- (2) The starting point for the existing store or location will be established by drawing a line at ninety (90) degrees with or to the nearest property line. The starting point for the proposed store or location for an alcoholic beverage license will be established by drawing a line at ninety (90) degrees with or to the nearest property line of that proposed location.

SECTION 3: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Appendix-A Zoning, Article VII TRANSIT ORIENTED CORRIDOR - CORRIDOR (TOC-C) DISTRICT, Section 7.3 TOC-C permitted uses, is hereby amended to read as follows 1 :

Section 7.3. - TOC-C Corridor permitted uses.

(A) [Permitted uses.] No building or structure, or part thereof, shall be erected, altered or used, or land or water used, in whole or in part, for other than any of the uses specified below.

. . .

Bars, and taverns. Not permitted within one thousand (1,000) feet of any church, school, or adult bookstore/theater.

. . .

Church, synagogue, and similar congregations of other religion and denominations, subject to the following:

- (a) That same shall not exceed seven thousand (7,000) square feet in gross area; and
- (b) That bingo and other similar games of chance are operated only as an accessory use; and

- (c) There shall be no academic parochial school on the subject site; and
- (d) That all distance requirements to a COP alcoholic beverage license are waived.
- (e) That a safe and adequate pedestrian circulation system has been provided.

. . .

Nightclubs, teen clubs, catering halls or dance halls, with an occupant load of less than two hundred fifty (250) persons. Minimum separation of one thousand (1,000) feet to nearest school or adult bookstore/theater. Subject to limitations of section 33.11 of this Code.

Package store. Not permitted within one thousand five hundred (1,500) feet of any other package store. Subject to requirements of section 33.11 of this Code.

- (B) Special exception uses. Special exception uses may be deemed appropriate to provide a complete distribution of commercial uses within the City, but because of their operational characteristics or area requirements need to be given individual consideration with respect to their location, access and relationship to adjacent properties and public rights-ofway, and conformity with the City's current and future redevelopment efforts.
 - (1) The following uses are authorized upon a finding by the City Commission that a special exception to the article is warranted, pursuant to the procedure and criteria set forth in Chapter 31, Section 31-54 of the Margate Code of Ordinances.
 - (n) Night clubs, teen clubs, catering halls or dance halls, with an occupancy greater than 250. Minimum separation of 1,000 feet to nearest school or adult bookstore/theater. Subject to limitations of section 33.11 of this Code.

SECTION 4: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Appendix-A Zoning, Article VIII TRANSIT ORIENTED CORRIDOR - GATEWAY (TOC-G) DISTRICT, Section 8.4 TOC-G permitted uses, is hereby amended to read as follows 1 :

Section 8.4. - TOC-G Gateway permitted uses.

(A) [Permitted uses.] No building or structure, or part thereof, shall be erected, altered or used, or land or water used, in whole or in part, for other than any of the uses specified below.

. . .

Bars, and taverns. Not permitted within one thousand (1,000) feet of any church, school, or adult bookstore/theater.

. . .

Church, synagogue, and similar congregations of other religion and denominations, subject to the following:

- (a) That same shall not exceed seven thousand (7,000) square feet in gross area; and
- (b) That bingo and other similar games of chance are operated only as an accessory use; and
- (c) There shall be no academic parochial school on the subject site; and
- (d) That all distance requirements to a COP alcoholic beverage license are waived.
- (e) That a safe and adequate pedestrian circulation system has been provided.

Nightclubs, teen clubs, catering halls or dance halls, with an occupant load of less than two hundred fifty (250) persons. Minimum separation of one thousand (1,000) feet to nearest school or adult bookstore/theater. Subject to limitations of section 33.11 of this Code.

 Package store. Not permitted within one thousand five hundred (1,500) feet of any other package store. Subject to requirements of section 33.11 of this Code.

SECTION 5: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Appendix-A Zoning, Article IX TRANSIT ORIENTED CORRIDOR - CITY CENTER (TOC-CC) DISTRICT, Section 9.5 TOC-CC permitted uses, is hereby amended to read as follows¹:

Section 9.5. - TOC-CC Gateway permitted uses.

(A) [Permitted uses.] No building or structure, or part thereof, shall be erected, altered or used, or land or water used, in whole or in part, for other than any of the uses specified below.

. .

Bars, and taverns. Not permitted within one thousand (1,000) feet of any church, school, or adult bookstore/theater.

. . .

Package store. Not permitted within one thousand five hundred (1,500) feet of any other package store. Subject to requirements of section 33.11 of this Code.

. . .

- (B) Special exception uses. Special exception uses may be deemed appropriate to provide a complete distribution of commercial uses within the City, but because of their operational characteristics or area requirements need to be given individual consideration with respect to their location, access and relationship to adjacent properties and public rights-of-way, and conformity with the City's current and future redevelopment efforts.
 - (1) The following uses are authorized upon a finding by the City Commission that a special exception to the article is warranted, pursuant to the procedure and criteria set forth in Chapter 31, Section 31-54 of the Margate Code of Ordinances.
 - (b) Church, synagogue, and similar congregations of other religion and denominations, subject to the following:
 - 1. That same shall not be permitted in any first-floor occupancy; and
 - That same shall only be permitted with an occupancy load of less than two hundred fifty (250) persons; and
 - 3. That bingo and other similar games of chance are operated only as an accessory use; and
 - 4. There shall be no academic parochial school on the subject site; and
 - 5. That all distance requirements to a COP alcoholic beverage license are waived; and
 - 6. That a safe and adequate pedestrian circulation system has been provided.

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(j) Night clubs, teen clubs, catering halls or dance halls, with an occupancy greater than 250. Minimum separation of 1,000 feet to nearest school or adult bookstore/theater. Subject to limitations of section 33.11 of this Code.

SECTION 6: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Appendix-A Zoning, Article XXI NEIGHBORHOOD BUSINESS B-1 DISTRICT, Section 21.3 Permitted uses, is hereby amended to read as follows¹:

Section 21.3. - Permitted uses.

(A) Permitted uses specified. No building or structure, or part thereof, shall be erected, altered or used, or land or water used, in whole or in part, for other than one of the following specified uses:

. . .

Church, synagogue, and similar congregations of other religion and denominations, subject to the following:

- (1) That same shall not exceed seven thousand (7,000) square feet in gross area.
- (2) That bingo and other similar games of chance are operated only as an accessory use.
- (3) There shall be no academic parochial school on the subject site.
- (4) There shall be no associated residence on the subject site.
- (5) That all distance requirements to a COP alcoholic beverage license are waived.
- (6) That a safe and adequate pedestrian circulation system has been provided.

(1) Not permitted within one thousand (1,000) feet of any church, school or adult bookstore/theater.

- (1) That same shall not exceed seven thousand (7,000) square feet in gross area.
- (2) That bingo and other similar games of chance are operated only as an accessory use.

- (5) That all distance requirements to a COP alcoholic beverage license are waived.

SECTION 10: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 11: If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 12: It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the City of Margate Code, and that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

SECTION 13: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
