If an establishment shares a common building 22 23 entrance with other businesses or uses which are not licensed to sell or serve alcohol, then the common entrance shall be 24 25 utilized for the measurement and twenty-five (25) feet shall be 26 added to the resulting measurement. SECTION 9: It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the City of Margate Code, and that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

SECTION 10: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
