1 2 3 Wall sign: A sign which is affixed to and supported by 4 wall or other enclosure. 5 Wayfinding sign: An off-premises sign with symbols, text, maps, or other similar graphics that are used to convey 6 7 location and directions to travelers. 8 Window: For purposes of this section a window is a set of 9 contiguous panels of glass or other transparent material 10 separated by dividers six (6) inches or smaller. 11 Window sign, interior: A sign located on the inside of a 12 window or within ten (10) feet of window or enclosed 13 structure which is visible from the exterior through a 14 window or other opening. 15 Window sign, exterior: A sign affixed or applied to the 16 exterior of a window. 17 The Code of the City of Margate, SECTION 2: 18 Florida, Appendix-A Zoning, Article XXXIX Sign Code Section 19 Section 39.17. - Prohibited signs, is hereby amended to read 20 as follows: 21 22 Section 39.17. - Prohibited signs. 23 The following signs are those signs which shall not be installed or displayed within the city unless specifically 24 25 identified and permitted in other sections of these regulations: 26 27 Abandoned signs. (A) 28 Advertising balloons or any windborne advertising or (B) 29 attention getting devices except as outlined in section 30 39.7 and section 39.8(F). 31 (C) Flashing signs. 32 (D) Banner signs except as a temporary grand opening sign 33 for approved special events, non-profit sales, or 34 academic schools or religious institutions (see section 35 39.7, "temporary signs"). 36 (E) Buntings, balloons and flags other than specifically 37 permitted this article.

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1	(F)	Obscene signs.
2 3	(G)	Off-premises signs and billboards, including off- premises project directional.
4	(H)	Pole signs.
5 6	(I)	Roof signs (except on a mansard) except where such sign is located on a parapet.
7	(J)	Snipe signs.
8 9 10 11	(K)	Temporary signs and permanent signs (other than public interest signs) placed on any public property (a shopping center parking lot shall not be deemed public property for the purposes of enforcing this section).
12	(L)	Any sign that could be confused with a traffic signal.

20 21 22		(1) Parked for more than three (3) hours in a twenty- four-hour period within one hundred (100) feet of any public right-of-way; and
23 24		(2) Visible from the street right-of-way that the vehicle is within one hundred (100) feet of; and
25 26 27 28 29 30 31		(3) Not regularly "used in the conduct of the business advertised" on the vehicle (A vehicle used primarily for the purpose of advertising, or for the purpose of providing transportation for owners or employees of the occupancy advertised on the vehicle, shall not be considered a vehicle used in the conduct of business); and
32 33 34 35 36 37 38 39 40		(4) Not parked in the rear of the parking lot or in the rear of the building which contains the business. On properties which do not provide a rear parking area, vehicle signs are parked in parking spaces immediately adjacent to the street right-of-way when other parking spaces are available on the premises, and are displayed in a manner that constitutes a prohibited sign per section 39.17 of the Margate Zoning Code.

1 (This section is not intended to prohibit any form of 2 vehicular signage such as a sign attached to a bus, 3 lettered on a motor vehicle or attached to or displayed from a taxicab which is not consistently 4 5 used as a stationary sign or advertisement. In the 6 instance where a sign advertising the sale of the 7 vehicle itself on the residential property of the registered owner of the vehicle, said sign shall be 8 9 considered a personal gain sign and shall be subject to all applicable provisions of such signs on the 10 11 owner's property. Furthermore vehicles displaying a vehicle sign parked on properties with physical 12 constraints which cannot accommodate location 13 14 requirements provided for in sections (1)-(4) above 15 shall be exempt from said requirements.) 16 Signs projecting horizontally in excess of twelve (12) (Q) inches from the structure upon which it is constructed. 17 18 Bench or bus shelter signs except those permitted by (R) section 39.8(A)(4). 19 20 (S) Signs painted directly upon any wall surface or 21 exterior of a door or window. 22 Signs which are erected upon private property and (T) extend into or above, or are anchored or placed in any 23 portion of the right-of-way of a city street or public 24 sidewalk, except grand projecting signs located in the 25 26 transit oriented corridor zoning districts. 27 (U) Signs attached to trees or other vegetative landscaping 28 material. 29 (V) Signs that emit sound, odor, visible matter or project 30 onto a structure or into the atmosphere any visual image by current or future technology including 31 means of 32 searchlights. 33 (W) Human signs. 34 35 All ordinances or parts of ordinances 36 SECTION 3: 37 in conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. 38 39 40 If any section, sentence, clause, SECTION 4: or phrase of this ordinance is held to be 41 invalid or 42 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then 43 said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the

2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13	<u>SECTION 5</u> : It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the City of Margate Code, and that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article" or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions. <u>SECTION 6</u> : This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
