A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING PURCHASE OF TWO DRONES ADDITIONAL EOUIPMENT TOENHANCE THE CAPABILITIES OF THE MARGATE POLICE DEPARTMENT AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS UNIT PROVIDING FOR FUNDING FROM THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida approves purchase of two drones and additional equipment to enhance the capabilities of the Margate Police Department Unmanned Aircraft Systems Unit (UAS), utilizing funds from the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund.

SECTION 2: That the expenditure is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Margate.

SECTION 3: The Chief of Police recommends the expenditure in State Law Enforcement Trust Funds ("LETFs") for the two drones and additional equipment for the Police Department.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 4}}$: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure in State LETFs for the two drones and additional equipment for the Police Department, in that the funds will be used for an appropriate law enforcement purpose.

SECTION 5: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure in State LETFs to for the two drones and additional equipment for the Police Department, in that the funds are not being used as a normal source of revenue for the Police Department.

SECTION 6: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure in State LETFs for the two drones and additional equipment for the Police Department in that the funds were not considered in the adoption and approval of the Police Department budget.

SECTION 7: That the Mayor and City Manager are authorized

and directed to execute contracts for the above acquisition, and the administration is authorized to issue a purchase order and execute all associated documents in order to implement same.
