## **Background**

• Comprehensive Plan required by Ch. 163, F.S.

- Plan consists of two volumes:
  - Data, Inventory & Analysis (DIA)
  - Goals, Objectives & Policies (GOPs)
- DIA provides foundation for GOPs

Only GOPs adopted. Allows flexibility for City to update DIA without complete amendment process (new to City, but common practice)

- Goals are broad, general policy statements
- Objectives and policies support goals
- Some policies required by Broward County [BCLUP xx]
- Per Ch. 163, F.S. details for implementation of GOPs belong in land development regulations



#### Goal 1

Ensure that the character and location of land uses maximize the potential for economic benefit and the enjoyment of natural and man-made resources by citizens while minimizing the threat to health, safety and welfare posed by hazards, nuisances, incompatible land uses, and environmental degradation.



#### Goal 2

Encourage the highest standards of urban development design and landscaping for the city as a whole, including districts within the city, and for individual site plans.



#### Goal 3

The cost of public infrastructure to service new developments and redevelopments shall be born by same, thereby maintaining a comparatively low rate of local taxation and public indebtedness.



#### Goal 4

<u>Preserve</u>, <u>protect</u> and <u>enhance</u> recreation and <u>open</u> <u>spaces</u>, <u>environmentally</u> <u>sensitive</u> areas, and <u>historic</u> resources.



### Goal 5

Utilize impact analysis and related factors in making decisions for proposals to develop land in Margate in a manner that is consistent with the future land use map and the other recommendations within this comprehensive plan.



#### Goal 6

Provide a high quality of life for all residents, use community planning efforts to prevent neighborhood decline, and maintain or restore the hometown atmosphere that allows residents to thrive socially and economically.



#### Goal 7

Design areas according to a plan that skillfully assigns uses to areas to create a sense of identity and appeal.









### Overall Concept Plan
