A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (LETF) TO BE USED FOR OVERTIME EXPENSES INCURRED FROM CRIME PREVENTION EFFORTS OF THE MARGATE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN ANY MULTI-AGENCY TASK FORCE GROUP; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida, approves utilizing funds from the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund for overtime expenses incurred from crime prevention efforts of the Margate Police Department's participation in any multi-agency task force group.

SECTION 2: That the expenditure is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Margate.

SECTION 3: The Chief of Police recommends the expenditure in State Law Enforcement Trust Funds ("LETFs") for overtime expenses incurred from crime prevention efforts of the Margate Police Department's participation in any multi-agency task force group.

SECTION 4: The Chief of Police certifies that the overtime expenses incurred from crime prevention efforts of the Margate Police Department's participation in any multi-agency task force group will be used for an appropriate law enforcement purpose.

SECTION 5: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure of State LETFs for overtime expenses incurred from crime prevention efforts of the Margate Police Department's participation in any multi-agency task force group, in that the funds are not being used as a normal source of revenue for the Police Department.

<u>SECTION 6</u>: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure in State LETFs for expenses incurred from crime prevention efforts of the Margate Police Department's participation in any multi-agency task force group in that the funds were not considered in the adoption and approval of the Police Department budget.

SECTION 7: That the Mayor and City Manager are authorized and directed to execute contracts for the above acquisition, and the administration is authorized to issue a purchase order and execute all associated documents in order to implement same.

SECTION 8: That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
