




## **SR-7 Multimodal Improvements Corridor Study**



- Study was completed and adopted by MPO Board in July 2016.
- The study area is a mile-wide corridor centered on SR-7 that runs from just south of the Miami-Dade County Line to north of Sample Road.
- The following goals were identified:
  - Improve safety for all users
  - Continue to improve transit service within the SR 7 corridor.
  - Invest in transportation solutions that are cost effective
  - Encourage land use and urban form to support multimodal transportation options
  - Reduce automobile traffic congestion without adversely impacting the mobility and/or
  - safety of cyclists, pedestrians, and transit users
- 8 groups of projects have moved to implementation

### **Project Scope**


- Project Limits: SW 11th St. from SR-7 to SW 49th St.

- ADA improvements throughout




#### **Project Schedule**

- Construction Start: Fall 2024








