AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, CHAPTER 39 WATER AND SEWERS -DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES, ARTICLE VIII - CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL/BACKFLOW PREVENTION, SECTION 39-108 AND SECTION 39-111; PROVIDING NEW RESPONSIBILITY FOR INSPECTION OF THE BACKFLOW PREVENTION SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR FEES TO BE SET BY RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION; PROVIDING REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF

MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Chapter 39 Water and Sewers - Department of Environmental and Engineering Services, Article VIII - Cross-Connection Control/Backflow Prevention, Section 39-108, shall be amended to read as follows1:

ARTICLE VIII. CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL/BACKFLOW PREVENTION

Sec. 39-108. Customer Rresponsibilities.

- (a) The customer shall continually maintain the backflow prevention assembly required by this article.
- (b) The customer's system shall be open for inspection at all reasonable times to authorized representatives of the director City to determine whether cross-connections or other threats to the utility system exist and for annual testing and renewal requirements.
- (c) The Department of Environmental and Engineering Services will be responsible for ensuring implementation of annual testing and renewal requirements for the backflow prevention assemblies in accordance with this Article.—It shall be the

duty of the customer at any premises where a required backflow prevention assembly is present, to have certified inspections and operational tests made at least once per year. In those instances where the director deems the hazard to be great enough, certified inspections may be required at more frequent intervals. Certified inspections shall also be required upon installation, after repair, after relocation, and after replacement.

- (d) All installations, inspections, tests, repairs, overhauls, or replacements of backflow prevention assemblies shall be at the sole expense of the customer and shall be performed by a licensed plumber under permit who is also a certified backflow prevention technician. If any backflow prevention assembly requires repair, overhaul, or replacement, such work shall be done within fifteen (15) calendar days of the notice to the customer of the need for such work. A copy of the record of all such tests or other work specified herein shall be reported to the city immediately upon receipt by the customer of the record.
- (e) Nothing herein shall relieve the owner of the responsibility for conducting, or causing to be conducted, periodic surveys of water use practices on the premises to determine where there are actual or potential cross connections in the customer system through which contaminants or pollutants could backflow into the water system.

SECTION 2: That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Chapter 39 Water and Sewers - Department of Environmental and Engineering Services, Article VIII - Cross-Connection Control/Backflow Prevention, shall be amended adding new Section 39-111. Fees, to read as follows:

Sec. 39-111. Fees

Fees for annual testing and renewal requirements of the backflow prevention assembly, including but not limited to double check valve assemblies for fire prevention systems and pressure vacuum breaker assemblies for irrigation systems, as well as certified inspections ordered by the Director of the Environmental and Engineering Services Department to address hazardous conditions of the backflow prevention assembly, shall be approved by resolution of the City Commission.
