### To answer your questions:

- 1. We currently also receive funding from the City of Hollywood and City of Miramar for schools in their cities.
- 2. We currently do not have a ReadingPals program at Atlantic West Elementary. If the Commissioners wish to use the money to hold the program at both Atlantic West & Margate Elementary, we can split the 30 first grade spots between both schools.
