A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE SEPTEMBER 1, 2012 INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND PARTICIPATING COMMUNITIES FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SUPPORT SERVICES INCLUDING RESIDENTIAL WASTE AND COMMERCIAL WASTE, YARD ("INTERLOCAL WASTE, AND BULK TRASH AGREEMENT"); PROVIDING FOR NON-BINDING INTENT FOR TRANSPORT, DELIVERY AND DEPOSIT OF YARD WASTE AND BULK TRASH; PROVIDING FOR RENEWAL OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR AN ADDITIONAL THE FIVE (5) YEARS THROUGH JULY 2, 2028, PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on December 5, 2012, the City Commission approved "An Interlocal Agreement Between Broward County and Participating Communities for Solid Waste Disposal and Support Services" ("Interlocal Agreement") to provide for the municipal solid waste, yard waste, and bulk trash disposal services that the City utilizes with Wheelabrator Environmental Systems Inc. ("Wheelabrator"); and,

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2018, the City Commission passed the "First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement for Solid Waste Disposal Support Services" to provide for renewal of the Interlocal Agreement for a second five-year term, under the same terms and conditions as the original; and

WHEREAS, historically, the City has elected to provide for collection, transportation, delivery, and deposit of yard waste and bulk trash, and specifically excludes construction and demolition debris, to/at the appropriate receiving facility of Wheelabrator; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to renew this ILA for an additional five (5) year term, up to and including July 2, 2028.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida hereby approves a Second Amendment to September 1, 2012 Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and Participating Communities for Solid Waste Disposal and Support Services including Residential Waste and Commercial Waste, to provide for communicating its non-binding intent for yard waste and bulk trash to go to Wheelabrator, and a five (5) year renewal through July 2, 2028.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Inerlocal Agreement on behalf of the City of Margate, a copy of which is attached and made a part of this Resolution.

<u>SECTION 3:</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
