A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A REGIONAL INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATIVE FIRE, RESCUE, EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, AND SPECIAL OPERATIONS RESPONSE THROUGH AUTOMATIC AID AND CLOSEST UNIT RESPONSE; PROVIDING FOR EQUIPMENT AND STAFFING; PROVIDING FOR REQUEST AND RESPONSE FOR AID; PROVIDING FOR CONTROL OF FIRE, RESCUE, EMS, AND SPECIAL OPERATIONS; PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, known as the "Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969," authorizes local governments to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities that will harmonize geographic, economic, population, and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and,

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Margate recognizes that there is a mutual advantage in providing automatic aid for closest unit response for life-threatening emergencies and cooperative use of the resources available among the affected Parties in order that lives and property may be saved.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida, hereby approves a Regional Interlocal Agreement for Cooperative Fire, Rescue, Emergency Medical Services, and Special Operations Response through Automatic Aid and Closest Unit Response.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City of Margate.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall become effective

immediately upon its passage.
