A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONTINUE DEVELOPMENT OF MOBILITY IMPROVEMENTS ALONG SW 11th STREET WITHIN CITY RIGHT OF WAY, FROM STATE ROAD 7 TO APPROXIMATELY SW 49th TERRACE; FURTHER EXPRESSING ITS INTENT TO TAKE OVER MAINTENANCE OF THE MOBILITY IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY RIGHT OF WAY.

BACKGROUND: The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) have identified a project to provide sidewalk improvements and, as an option, shared lane arrows (sharrows) on SW 11th Street. FDOT will design and manage the project, and after completion, the City of Margate will assume maintenance responsibility.
