**BACKGROUND:** The Police Department has received a significant number of complaints regarding business practices by towing companies when conducting nonconsent tows. This proposed ordinance will provide for additional protections to consumers and improve enforceability by the Police Department and Code Compliance Officers.

The rates have been updated to reflect the Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment and prevailing rates already provided for by City Code.
