RESOLUTION - APPROVING FULL FUNDING OF THE FIVE (5) EXISTING POSITIONS OF ASSISTANT BUILDING DIRECTOR AND FOUR (4) CHIEF INSPECTORS FOR THE BUILDING AND CODE SERVICES DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR BUDGET AMENDMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**BACKGROUND:** When the Assistant Directors position was created a “toggle” was placed on the position, stating the Assistant Director would also perform the Duties of Chief Inspector. Because the Assistant Directors position is non-bargained for, and the Chief Inspector position is bargained for it is not possible for one person to fill both positions. As a result, the toggle between the two positions needs to be removed, creating an Assistant Directors position unto itself.
