RESOLUTION - PROVIDING FOR SALARY COST OF LIVING INCREASES FOR CITY COMMISSIONERS AT THE SAME PERCENTAGE COST OF LIVING INCREASES AS PROVIDED TO SENIOR MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES.

**BACKGROUND:** Section 3.06. - Compensation and expenses.  
 (1) The Commission may determine the annual salary of Commissioners, except as provided in [subsection] (2) of this section. An ordinance or resolution increasing such salary shall become effective coincident with and at the time of the adoption of the next City budget.

**RECOMMENDATION:** For consideration by the City Commission.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** \$3,300 based upon a hypothetical 2% COLA increase (not including fringe) for Senior Management (increases: Mayor-\$678, Vice Mayor-\$673, Commissioners-\$653 each)
