CONSIDERATION OF AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDED AND RESTATED FRANCHISE AGREEMENT FOR SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL COLLECTION; PROVIDING FOR SHORT TERM EXTENSION.

**BACKGROUND:** On February 4, 2015, the City Commission directed that the Franchise Agreement with Waste Management, for single family residential and commercial collection, be amended to extend the contract for two months, in order to allow Waste Management the opportunity to speak to the City regarding a possible renewal of the franchise agreement, while staff simultaneously works on the RFP. This Ordinance provides for a sixty (60) day extension with additional sixty (60) day extension option.
