AUTHORIZING THE RECLASSIFICATION OF THE SYSTEMS ANALYST POSITION INTO THE TECHNOLOGY APPLICATION SPECIALIST POSITION AND TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT SPECIALIST POSITION WITHIN THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT

BACKGROUND: Information Technology provides a backbone service to which every department depends on. There has been a shift in City-wide applications over the past four years which has led to an increase in demand on Information Technology services and staff.
