BACKGROUND: On November 2, 2016 the City Commission approved a six month moratorium via Ordinance 2016-11 for the approval of any medical marijuana dispensary and similar type businesses. This proposed ordinance is to provide for a six month extension of this existing six month moratorium on the approval of any medical marijuana dispensaries within the City of Margate until the State Legislature provides further clarification and guidance associated with these types of businesses.

This item passed on First Reading at the May 3, 2017, Regular City Commission meeting.
