CONSIDERATION OF A TEMPORARY USE PERMIT (TUP), TO ALLOW A CARNIVAL AT 1000 N STATE ROAD 7, FROM DECEMBER 22 - DECEMBER 31, 2017.

BACKGROUND: The Margate Waterfront Foundation is seeking permission to permit a carnival at 1000 N State Road 7. Event dates would range from December 22 - 31, 2017, event set-up and take down would take place 3 days prior and 3 days after the event. Applicant is also seeking permission to operate a carnival until midnight; Code requires events to close by 10 P.M. unless otherwise approved by City Commission.
