SUBMITTING TO REFERENDUM AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE III, ENTITLED "LEGISLATIVE " AND SPECIFICALLY SECTION 3.02, "QUALIFICATIONS OF COMMISSIONERS", SUBSECTION B "TERM LIMITATIONS" AND SECTION 3.04 "ELECTIONS AND TERMS" OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, TO ABOLISH TERM LIMITS FOR THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS; PROVIDING FOR A NOTICE OF AN ADVERTISEMENT OF THE REFERENDUM ELECTION TO BE PUBLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE WHEN ADOPTED, SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, AT THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION, AND SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE AS PROVIDED BY LAW; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BACKGROUND: At the May 11, 2018, City Commission Workshop, the City Commission voted to bring this item back as an Ordinance for First and Second Readings to be added to the November 6, 2018 Election Ballot as a Referendum item.

The City Commission approved first reading of this ordinance with a 3-2 vote on May 16, 2018.
