RESOLUTION - APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, THE CITY OF NORTH LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, THE CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS, FLORIDA, AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, FOR SHARING THE COST OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF A BACTERIA POLLUTION CONTROL PLAN; PROVIDING FOR REQUIREMENT OF THE NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) MUNICIPAL STORM SEWER PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF \$8,938.90 FOR THE CITY OF MARGATE'S FAIR SHARE.

**BACKGROUND:** The National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit requires the development of a Bacteria Pollution Control Plan (BPCP) to address pollution levels within an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)-designated impaired waterbody of the permittees' choice through a prioritization process. This Agreement provides for sharing the cost, with participating municipalities, for the development of the BPCP for the C-14 Cypress Creek Canal.
