CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF JONATHAN SHAW AS POLICE CHIEF; PROVIDING FOR TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BACKGROUND:** Ordinance 2018-4 (Charter Section 4.08), approved by referendum in the November 2018 general election, provides that the City Commission reserves the power of appointment, suspension and removal of the Police Chief. As Jonathan Shaw was already appointed Police Chief, prior to the effective date of Ordinance 2018-4, this Resolution provides the opportunity for the City Commission to confirm appointment of the Police Chief pursuant to Section 4.08 of the City Charter.
