### BACKGROUND:

In accordance with the Florida Contraband Act, the Margate Police Department is required to expend or donate no less than twenty-five percent (25%) of the fiscal years total collection of state forfeiture funds to a charitable organization within the guidelines of Florida State Statute 932.7055.

The Florida Missing Children's Day Foundation Inc. was created pursuant to FS 683.231 to provide Florida Department of Law Enforcement with assistance, funding, and promotional support for activities authorized for Florida Missing Children. Each year parents, children, law enforcement officers and citizens gather to remember Florida's missing children who are still missing and those who will never return home.
