A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT RELATED TO COVID-19 EMERGENCY ORDER ENFORCEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND CITY OF MARGATE; PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION; PROVIDING FOR TERM; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to Section 8-56 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, the City is authorized to implement and enforce the provisions of Emergency Orders issued by Broward County. This Interlocal Agreement (ILA) provides for enforcement of the Emergency Orders within municipal boundaries by the City and for the County to reimburse the City for said enforcement.

RECOMMENDATION: For approval.

FISCAL IMPACT: Broward County shall provide a monthly payment to the City in the amount of \$14,000, totaling an amount not to exceed \$98,000 for the Enforcement Period.
