**BACKGROUND: iN2L** (It is never 2 Late) Pilot Program funded by the Department of Elder Affairs DOEA, is a technology program geared to engage older adults in a variety of activities such as games, virtual travel, learning, exercising and communicating with family members and peers. Socialization has become challenging due to the COVID pandemic, this program is an important lifeline to keep the seniors mentally and physically healthy. Each participant receives an iPad sponsored by DOEA. NW Focal Point Senior Center staff trains and guides the individuals through this new journey.

This contract provides funding for staff to deliver the program.
