ORDINANCE - AMENDING CHAPTER 30 PERSONNEL, SECTION 30-23 "COVERED PERSONNEL"; TO PROVIDE FOR THE INCLUSION OF THE APPOINTED POLICE MAJOR POSITION AS A COVERED PERSONNEL POSITION FOR PURPOSES OF CIVIL SERVICE CODE PROTECTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BACKGROUND: The recently approved personnel Ordinance 2022-5 provided that all police positions above Captain would not be considered covered personnel under the civil service system. This ordinance clarifies Section 30-23 to clarify that the assigned Police Major position would be a covered civil service position.
